World

Conference Participants met virtually in July, September and November, 2023.

In July, we discussed the World Convention, Aug 29 thru Sep 1, 2024. The Power of Love, convention 38. Registration is open and hotel information and rooms are also available on line. NA has developed a new system of finding meetings and service bodies. More information available before the end of the year. World has formed workgroups for 1) WSC of the future project; 2) BPG Invest in Our Vision project; 3) WCNA; 4) focus groups and 5) Web meetings; as well as surveys, workshops for IDT's and input on review drafts. We workshopped Issue Discussion Topics (IDTs) to develop discussion questions in order to frame the topics.

September: IDTs are ready to workshop with the fellowship as a whole. This region will be discussing these topics at the Regional Assembly, February 24, 2024 from 9 am - 5 pm. The topics are posted on NA.org/IDT. Feel free to check out the topics to discuss with your areas, home groups, and other recovering addicts. We then discussed the Internal and External factors (within NA) prioritized at WSC 2023 that are impacting the ability to achieve our vision. The survey that has been available on NA.org addresses these issues, asking for fellowship input.

November: Discussion around reimagining and revitalizing service committees. Discussed how delegates can help local service bodies take inventory and begin gathering ideas and rebuilding and reimagining service delivery. Anthony reported on the upcoming changes to World Services' meeting finder page and app. He stated there was an open webinar last week. The recording is posted on www.na.org/meetingsearch. He requested that everyone encourage their local web servants and phone line trusted servants who handle meeting information to watch the video and help gather the data needed to make your meetings easier to find. Anthony stated that they hoped to switch to the new system by the end of this calendar year but will push later if needed in order to make sure it is as ready as it can be. He added that it is no longer necessary to submit registration for new groups. They will no longer be registering new groups that have access to local service bodies. It is very important to be sure that your local NA service body is aware of any new NA groups so that they can be included in the listings. He added that World Services is only dealing with updates for meeting information they already have. He thanked everyone who has helped by returning the information needed.
