



Regional Public Relations Report
April 10, 2021

Public Relations met with 5 Areas, 1 Metro (4 Areas) present. Areas represented were Primary Purpose (Adam, Billie, and Chelsea), Stan (Little Egypt), Susan (GSCA), Whitney (So Central), Darla (St Louis) and Scott M. Kansas City Metro (Heartland, Northland, United Kansas City and West Central Areas).

Darla attended by Zoom and sent a website report of incorrect links? I'm not sure what exactly needs to be done with these.

Chelsea (PI Chair for Primary Purpose) provided a written report "There was a PI presentation via Zoom with Preferred Family Treatment Center in Kirksville, MO, Drug Court, and Probation and Parole. The two members that facilitated said that it was a successful presentation. There will be another presentation at some point in the future. They are also compiling a mailing list of addresses of professionals. That mailing will take place when all the government agencies are open up fully to in person activity." We also had a discussion of Phone line options.

Susan (GSCA) was interested in website.

Whitney (PR Chair for South Central) Reported that they are currently trying to restock the PR racks in the 7 counties that they service. She is the only one on her committee, so she is reaching out to contact volunteers in each county to have the racks restocked. They have recently placed a literature order for the pamphlets that they will need. They have flyers printed and are waiting for confirmation on the phonenumber to post them. Mid-Mo Phonenumber info was confirmed.

Stan (Little Egypt) nothing going on right now.

Scott reported that Kansas City Metro has printed Flyers and Business Cards and are having success with get them placed in various locations that are "targeted" areas that people who are likely to struggle with addiction might frequent: Jackson County DFS, Counseling Services, Behavioral Health Centers, Jackson County DOC (every person discharged from Jackson County Jail has a business card placed in their discharge packet), and EMS and Fire Departments. We have a PSA done and have a motion to rm a PR Facebook page to promote the PSA.

We are planning a PR week event for Saturday June 12th from 3:30 to 5:30pm. It will be a hybrid event. The Zoom Code is 981-6449-1436 PW PR. Everyone in the region is invited to attend. We will have 4 speakers Paul F from the World Board will be talking about International PR efforts, Tom K will be doing his H&I presentation, local members Ruth W will talk about PR locally and Tom H will talk about local H&I.


