July 10th 2021

April Conference Participants Meeting

- Literature orders are still 18% under budget, not useful at this point to plot date from
- Most expenses are still under budget except legal and inhouse production.
- Under normal circumstances the NAWS budget is \$5.5million, the goal is to fund 70% of the budget or \$3,885,000 by member contributions, currently member contributions are about 1 million.
- If 10,000 members gave \$20 a month and 10,000 gave \$10 a month that would be just about that amount.
- Thank you to everyone who is already donating.
- Most of the projects from the 2020 CAR have not been addressed, so please keep that in mind when making 2022 CAR motions.
- The English-language 5th Edition Basic Text. We also have Arabic, Hungarian, Russian, Spanish, and Thai posted.
- We conducted an environmental in small groups and came back together to discuss results. Questions included: Were regions meeting virtually or in-person, areas same question. How has pandemic effected newcomers to meetings? Are groups starting to go back to in-person, remaining virtual, hybrid, or some combination?

April Southern Zone Meeting

- Decided we would meet at MZSS in August 26-29th (Hybrid) and Louisville, Kentucky in-person October 29-31st.

June Conference Participants Meeting

- Financial status is holding steady, not expecting to come back to full funding until after the pandemic and all meeting resume in person.
- 4 of the 24 furloughed staff have been brought back to do mission critical work.
- WCNA 28 contract was signed with Melbourne, Australia Convention Center for November 2022. There is no penalty for cancelation at this point.
- WSC 2022 Face to face does not seem realistic at this point:
 - i) Travel Restrictions
 - ii) Financial Considerations
- Will the Region pay our expenses if we do have a Face to Face WSC?
- Virtual Meeting Survey Workgroup Report-not ready to report yet, but consensus appears to be "yes" virtual meetings meet the requirements to be a meeting, although not consistent among countries reporting.
- HRP (Human Resource Panel) is asking nominees for an RBZ (Region-Zone-Board) nomination this cycle. I would like for us to nominate Mindy A-W for the World Board. I believe that you were sent her resume, but if not I've hyper linked it. I believe she will be here this afternoon for sharing session so you can question her.



Chelsea (PI Chair for Primary Purpose) Not much to report. Wants to be added to Phoneline Workshop when Mid Mo holds it.


Stan (Little Egypt) nothing going on right now.

For a greater part of my time clean, I have been bothered with the funding of our World Services relative to the Seventh Tradition (self-support) . Currently, we fund them with literature sales.

As of 2019, our contributions provide just 10% of the income. There are 2 attachments that show both that 10% and a possible solution to the problem submitted by World Services.

1. Conference Agenda Report-2019
2. April 2020 NAWS NEWS

The thousand and million numbers are hard for me to fathom. After analyzing the amount a different way, the goal does not seem so daunting. Breaking down the numbers locally(Regionally), the goal appears to be a possibility we might address.

Therefore, I am proposing two plans as examples Goals without plans are seldom met.

I am suggesting that we ask for a minimum of 20 volunteer leaders to bring together 20 members of the fellowship to individually donate World Services Needless to say, the number of members and their individual donations would vary, but the goal would be the same. Donations would be \$20 a month (\$240 a year) or \$10 (\$120 a year) on a recurring basis or as a one- time donation per year.

The following are two examples of how that might work:


Given that we have several metropolitan areas plus a good number of rural areas, I would hope we could accept a plan as a possibility and join-together in exploring and implementing it.

My hope is, that at some point, we could reduce the price of a Basic Text to \$5.00 or below. This might allow us to provide a text to all newcomers and all those coming into Hospitals & Institutions. Further, we might be able to supply professionals in our Public Relations efforts.

In addition, we could provide a model for other Regions to use.

Each dollar would be listed as a part of individual donations coming from our Region.

Basic Financial Statements: An Overview



This section is our primary delivery method of financial information to interested members and outside parties, as required by law to maintain our nonprofit status.

Contributions from Members, Groups, and Service Bodies


As most of our members understand, the fact that NA World Services must operate as a business does not change the spiritual nature of our goals as an organization. The goals outlined in A Vision for NA Service, approved at WSC 2010, continue to guide everything we do. The enduring pursuit of this vision inspires us to provide the highest level of services we can, as documented in the remainder of this *Annual Report*.

While this FY saw Fellowship contributions decrease by 1% percent, we are deeply inspired by your contribution efforts, and we are grateful for your shared commitment to Tradition Seven and A Vision for NA Service. Thank you!

In the graph to the right, you'll find Fellowship contributions for FY 2019 in five different categories—individuals, groups, areas, regions, and zonal forums/events—over the last six years. Altogether, Fellowship contributions currently make up 10% percent of total NAWS operating income, which can be seen in the chart on the next page.

The detailed list that follows, organized by region, will allow you to analyze contributions in your corner of the globe. We color coded the different types


Contributions by Donor Type

of contributors in this report to allow the reader to notice trends at a glance. As you'll see, our practices vary from region to region.

Consolidated Statements

The Consolidated Statement of Financial Position (SoFP) and Consolidated Statement of Activities (SoA) summarize the financial activity of NA World Services during the 2019 fiscal year. The SoFP, also known as a balance sheet, gives a simple breakdown of the current NAWS financial assets and liabilities. The SoA, commonly known as an income statement, provides an analysis of the total income and expenses for all branches of NAWS compared to the budget adopted at WSC 2018.

Under each set of expenses, we include allocated costs for accounting, personnel, overhead, and technology. We calculate a fixed percentage each cycle to divide these costs among four areas of activity: literature production and distribution, World Service Conference support, Fellowship development, and events. We base the percentages on three factors: the number of personnel required, estimated labor hours, and the amount of physical office space. Other indirect costs, such as electricity, water, insurance, and taxes, are also estimated for the two-year budget cycle and included as part of these fixed or operational costs.

For fiscal year 2019, we continued to see a decline in literature sales and contributions. With decreasing sales and increasing demand, we were already challenged to meet our mission before the pandemic changed our operations and income, as we have already said in the 2020 Conference Approval Track material.

For fiscal year 2019, you will see excess expense over revenue, before WCNA 37, of \$1,399,269. With the

income from the World Convention in Orlando factored in, the final figures for the year change to expense over income of \$300,025. The budget approved at WSC 2018 expected net income over expense.

So what changed? Why are the final figures so different from the figures forecast in the budget? Most of the discrepancy is the result of three factors. Recovery literature income was 5%, or \$433,727, less than budgeted; contributions were 27%, or \$298,480, less than budgeted; and the total of free and subsidized literature was a record high at \$832,316, which was 68%, or \$266,636, more than budget. The total of these three areas over what was budgeted was \$998,843, which was 71% of the excess expense over revenue for 2019, excluding Orlando. (We say "excluding Orlando" because having a World Convention in a location like Orlando is an unusual event and not something that will be repeated this cycle.)

We were able to keep many expenses under budget, including travel, World Board, and workgroups; and some expenses exceeded budget, including personnel, overhead, and the category labeled literature production and distribution travel and exchange expenses. All of the allocated expenses—Accounting, Personnel, Overhead, and Technology—came in at more than 10% over budget, but the dollar amounts for technology and accounting are not significant. This is simply an indicator that fixed expenses have increased over the last two years. The personnel costs for 2019 were 11%, or \$418,942, over budget, and overhead was 17%, or \$352,334, over the budgeted amount. The line item under fixed operational expenses, which is literature production and distribution travel and exchange expenses, came in \$153,617, over budget due to an ever-changing economy around the world and activities to standardize literature production in Russia.

FINANCES

Our financial situation continues to fluctuate. We are working hard to weather the storm. We remain under budget for all expense categories except in-house production and legal.

We have less control over income. By the end of last year, our literature sales began to improve, but net literature income was still almost 40% less than the same time the previous year. A significant percentage of the literature being ordered has been coming from correctional and treatment facilities, many of which have been locked down with H&I panels not able to reach them.

As the world is opening back up, literature sales are beginning to increase, but we remain committed to becoming more self-supporting through member contributions. Our long-term goal is to cover at least 70% of our expense for services from contributions not literature sales. Those services are roughly two-thirds of our budget; it's most of what we do, except for literature distribution and cost of goods.

Under more normal circumstances (not a pandemic), World Services' expense for services are approximately \$5.5 million, 70% of which is approximately \$3,885,000 per year. In the last fiscal year, contributions were just under one million dollars, which means we are a little more than a quarter of the way toward the goal.

Thank you so much to everyone who has made a contribution. Recurring monthly contributions are the most sustainable source of income for us, and we are happy to report that the total amount of member contributions had increased more than tenfold over the course of the last year. We have gone from fewer than 50 recurring contributors with a total of about \$2,000 per month, in February 2020, to over 750 members contributing a total of more than \$20,000 a month. Our only income area that improved in the last fiscal year was contributions. Thank you.

Addicts can do anything when we put our minds to it. If 10,000 members contributed \$10 per month and another 10,000 contributed \$20 per month, we would almost reach our goal.





- website will not violate any restrictions imposed by applicable law on IRC Section 501(c)(3) entities, including but not limited to those proscribing political activity or proscribing the use of Your income or assets for a private purpose or impermissible benefit;
- ii. You understand that You are receiving the contribution because a donor made a donation to NFG-DAF and recommended that NFG-DAF make a grant of that donation, after applicable fees, to Your charity. NFG-DAF has exclusive legal control over all donations it receives, even where the donor makes recommendations in connection with those donations;
 - iii. You understand You may have obligations to register under, and covenant that You shall fully comply and bear the costs associated with, any and all applicable state and local statutes governing the solicitation of charitable solicitations, including but not limited to fulfilling any registration requirements thereof;
 - iv. You have registered with the GuideStar Information System at www.guidestar.org website and You will update the GuideStar Information System with any relevant changes;
 - v. You have completed and submitted the Electronic Funds Transfer Authorization Agreement, if this is Your preferred payment method;
 - vi. You shall promptly notify Network for Good of any change in Your tax-exempt status, and any inquiry by the IRS or any state or local government regarding the matters described in (a) and (b) above;
 - vii. the donor of any online donation will not receive, nor be promised to receive, any valuable goods or services as a result of such donation, including but not limited to tax credits, sweepstakes entries, raffle entries or material goods, unless we are acting as an agent providing such services on Your behalf
 - viii. You grant Network for Good the authority to collect donations on Your behalf, and consent to the use of Your organization's name on the Websites; and
 - ix. The Giving System cannot be used to process membership, raffle tickets, sweepstakes entries, merchandise or service payments, or to accept donations that were not made directly by the donor to Your organization through the Giving System.
- 7. PROCESS OF RECEIVING DONATIONS THROUGH THE GIVING SYSTEM.**
- a. When a donor recommends to NFG-DAF that it make a grant to You, NFG-DAF will be able to make a grant to You as long as You satisfy NFG-DAF's legal requirements. The grant, less any amounts retained by NFG-DAF for processing costs, which costs shall be disclosed to You at the time we distribute donations to You. At the time of donation, we give donors the option to pay these processing costs, so that You receive the full donation amount.
 - b. If You have signed up to receive disbursements through electronic funds transfer, then NFG-DAF will combine all individual donations to You into a single grant, net of any offsets, and such grants shall be disbursed to You within thirty (30) days at the end of each month. If You are receiving disbursements through checks, the

aggregate donations totaling at least \$9.51, net of processing costs ("Minimum Disbursement Amount"), shall be disbursed to You within thirty (30) days after the end of each month. You are responsible for reviewing all donation disbursements carefully and reporting any concerns to Network for Good within fifteen (15) days of receipt. Failure to do so will limit your rights and ability and obligation to respond. NFG-DAF shall have the right to update the Minimum Disbursement Amount from time to time in its sole discretion. If donations directed to You do not meet the Minimum Disbursement Amount, NFG-DAF will hold donations to You until the sum of the aggregate donations meets the Minimum Disbursement Amount. Notwithstanding the foregoing, NFG-DAF shall disburse any donations to You, net of processing costs, at least every twelve (12) months, regardless of whether or not such amount is less than the Minimum Disbursement Amount.

c. As donations are not refundable to the donor, NFG-DAF retains the right to re-grant donations to another charity if You are no longer in good standing as a public charity with the IRS, if You appear on the Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) list of organizations with suspected ties to terrorism or if You have not cashed checks issued by NFG-DAF to You within 6 months of the date of issue.

8. **CANCELLED CONTRIBUTIONS.**

a. Donor Initiated Credit Card Contribution Cancellations: Except as described in Section 16(b), donations processed by NFG-DAF are final and may not be refunded.

b. Credit Card Company Charge Backs and Disputed Charges: In the event Network for Good receives notification of a charge back or a disputed charge from a credit card company as a result of a donation granted to You. Network for Good shall have the right to:

i. Deduct charge back amounts from Your future grant checks until the charge back and related administrative fees are paid in full.

ii. Terminate Your access to the Giving System; and/or

iii. Pursue any necessary legal action in order to recover the disputed charge back amounts. You acknowledge and agree that if Network For Good finds You did not, in good faith, attempt to refund Network for Good with the charge back amount in question, then You will pay for all of Network for Good's expenses (including, but not limited to, courts costs and attorney fees) related to any legal action initiated for the purpose of recovering the disputed charge back amounts from You.

You agree that Network for Good will not be liable for any interruptions or errors in using the Donate Now URL. The provisions of this section shall survive your cessation of use of the Services, including, without limitation, the Giving System.

10. INDEMNIFICATION.

You agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Network for Good, their parents, subsidiaries, and affiliates, and their respective officers, directors, agents, distributors, franchisees, and employees against any loss, damage, expense, or cost, including reasonable attorneys' fees (including allocated costs for in-house legal services) arising out of any claim, demand, action, suit, investigation, arbitration, or other proceeding by a third party based on (i) your material breach or the inaccuracy of any covenant, duty, representation, or warranty set forth in these Terms & Conditions, (ii) materials contained on your website (including any allegation that such materials infringe a third party's proprietary rights), and (iii) any other aspect of your activities or your website and the content thereon.
