### St. Louis Area of NA RCM Report

The most pressing issue for our area for the past 4 months has been the Covid-19 pandemic resulting in mass lockdowns and the closing of meetings for addicts to attend. As soon as it became clear that our areas and surrounding areas were being shut down, the four PR committees in our directory which includes 4 areas came together to form the "Quad." Our immediate goal was to get a virtual meeting started twice per day at noon and 7 pm. We did this by dividing up the meetings between each of the 4 PR committees. Within 3 (3-17-20) days we had the 14 meetings up and running. We participated in several na.org's workshops to become familiar with the use of the Zoom platform. Various home groups began to step forward wanting to host their meetings. We set up a training program where we could train the addicts how to host and participate in the Zoom meetings. By the end of April we had 62 meetings up and running at which time, the PR subcommittees stepped away, for the most part from the day to day running of the meetings.

At the same time we did an e-blast to approximately 300 treatment facilities, probation and parole offices and other groups and individuals that we had in our contacts to give them the information as to where to find our local virtual meetings as well as virtual meetings around the globe.

As our meetings have opened back up according to county regulations we have kept our meeting lists up to date. We have written a second letter to send out to the professionals that will go out this week.

We have started to redo our website using the BMLT system.

None of this would have been possible without the hard work and dedication of many addicts across our areas working together to give the still suffering addict a place to go.
